NOTICE OF CHANGE IN RATES - Commercial

Starting May 1st 2023, you will see changes to the rates you pay at Capital Electric Cooperative. The Grid Capacity Component on your bill will increase from \$0.50 per kW to \$1.25 per kW. Some of that increase will be offset by a reduction in the usage/energy charge as it will decrease from \$0.0523 to \$0.0485. The monthly base charge and demand charge components will remain constant.

The Cooperative knows that these are trying times for many of our members as cost pressures are being felt from all sides. We do not enjoy adding to that list. If you would like to explore ideas on how to best position yourself in relation to these changes, we do have some options for you:

- 1) Optional rate structures
- 2) Off Peak Programs
- 3) Energy efficiency/load balancing improvements/enhancements
