

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HOW TO READ YOUR BILL

Follow the numbers below as a guide to reading your new billing format.

- 1. On-Peak Event Message: This message communicates the peak date and time for the billing period. This window of time is determined by our wholesale power provider.
- **Grid Capacity Message:** This message communicates the date within the last 12 months that your electric service called for the greatest amount of electricity.
- Monthly Base Charge: These are the costs to run CEC. This covers everything from responding to outages to generating your monthly electric bill. Whether crews are out maintaining the power lines or office staff are submitting a regulatory filing; there are costs that exist regardless of how much power is consumed in the month.
- **Energy Charge (kWh):** CEC purchases energy at a wholesale rate. This portion of your bill is indexed to those wholesale costs. The wholesaler is primarily passing along the cost of the fuel to generate the electricity with this component.
- 5. On-Peak Charge: This is based on how much energy you consumed during the peak half-hour period during the month. The period is determined by the wholesale power provider and is generally set during the most extreme weather of the month or when the majority of consumers are experiencing a time of higher than average energy consumption.
- **Grid Capacity Charge:** This element is based on what it costs to build the distribution power grid to your home or business. This includes poles, wires, transformers, and meters that bring the power from the substation to you. We design the system to handle what we understand to be your highest need. The investments made in these assets are long-term in nature and exist regardless of what level of consumption is achieved. To recognize that, this component of your bill is based on your highest demand for electricity within the last 12 months.
